The Station Teams Competition is run in conjunction with the existing events held at the A.B.C. Amateur Race Meet held from the 24 - 27 June 2021 at Brunette Downs.

The Competition is restricted to stations residing within the Tennant Creek DPI area.

The Race Club encourages the winning stations to use the donation of the prize money/funds to purchase items for the direct use and benefit of the staff members on their station.

RULES:

- ✓ Each team is to be made up of 4 competitors that are employees on the station - 2 of which must be jackaroos/jillaroos (a member of the stock camp with 3 or less years of experience)
 - ✓ Each team must nominate 1 horse in the Plant Horse Sprint and that horse earns points in the same way as a person
 - ✓ A prize of a voucher for a Fender Saddle (sponsored by local Social/Recreation Clubs & Kent Saddlery) is awarded to the individual who earns the highest overall score in the competition
 - ✓ There are 6 events that can be entered over the 4 day event (listed below)
1. Plant Horse Sprint
 2. Jackaroo / Jillaroo Campdraft
 3. Maiden Campdraft
 4. Barrel Race
 5. Bullock Ride (only one competitor from each team will earn for the team for this event as there are restricted nominations, points earned will not count to highest overall score)
 6. Battle of the Barkly Ironman / Ironwoman (if B of B noms fill, only one competitor from each team will earn points for the team for this event as there are restricted nominations, and points earned will not count to highest overall score)

PLEASE NOTE: If a competitor has more than one horse in the Jackaroo/Jillaroo Draft, Maiden Draft or Barrel Race, the competitor **must** nominate the horse in which they wish to earn the points on prior to the event.

Scoring system:

- 1st place = 6 points
- 2nd place = 5 points
- 3rd place = 4 points
- 4th place = 3 points
- 5th place = 2 points
- Participation = 1 point

The winning teams & recipient of the saddle will be decided by Sunday 27th June & presentations will be made to the winners. The Committee's decision is final.

All stations residing in the Tennant Creek DBIRD area will be eligible for nomination.
