NOMINATIONS

Nominations are via Campdraft Central

Limit of 8 first round runs per person

NO PAYMENT NO RIDE, NOMINATIONS MUST BE PAID IN FULL BEFORE COMPETING

A win will break status of rider and/or horse unless otherwise specified

Prize money will be paid according to ACA Rules R.6- R.9

JACK & JILL DRAFT

For competitors 17 years and over, who have not won 1x Encouragement or 1x Open age draft or placed 3x times in an Open Campdraft. Horse will be verified with Station manager and reside within Tennant Creek DPIFM Boundary. Must be riding a Maiden station bred horse. Due to the added restrictions, this event is not an encouragement. As a result, the horse's status will break status in accordance with Rule 9.1 & Rule 9.2. HELMETS MUST BE WORN. Restricted to 1x run per rider.

ENCOURAGEMENT DRAFT

Competitors must be 17yrs & over, not won 1x Encouragement or 1x Open age Campdraft, or placed 3x times in an Open age Campdraft. A win will not alter the status of the horse. Restricted to 1x run per rider.

HELMETS MUST BE WORN.

LADIES DRAFT

Restricted to riders not participating in Jack & Jill, Encouragement & Open. Limited to 1x run per rider.

HORSE AGE

A horse age is of 1st August 2021 as per ASCA guidelines

ACA

ACA affiliated – all competitors must be financial ACA members

REFUNDS

All refunds as per ACA guidelines

ACA TERMS & CONDITIONS:

1. AFFILIATION: Events are ACA Affiliated.

2. HELMETS: Riders under the age of 18 must wear helmets whilst mounted on a horse at all ACA affiliated events. Helmets must comply with current Australian and New Zealand safety standards and must be securely fastened under the chin at all times.

3. SCRATCHING: A 100% refund of the nomination fee will be given if the competitor withdraws more than 168 hours (7 days) prior to 8:00am on the first morning of the program. If a competitor withdraws less than 168 hours (7 days prior to 8:00am on the first morning of the program), then the entire nomination fee may be retained by the committee. If the committee deems that extenuating circumstances apply, then a refund may be granted. Each case will be at the discretion of the committee.

4. HORSE'S STATUS: The status of a horse winning a campdraft will be determined by the highest class of horse that competes with the exception of Juniors, Juveniles, Ladies, Men's, Old Buffers, Associates and Encouragement Campdrafts.

5. NOMINATION: Your ACA membership number must be provided otherwise your nomination will not be processed.

6. ENCOURAGEMENT: An Encouragement campdraft competitor shall be 17 years and over and one who has not won 1 Encouragement or 1 Open age draft, or placed 3 times in an Open age campdraft.

7. JUVENILE/JUNIOR: Juvenile (13 years to under 17 years) and Juniors (8 years to under 13 years).

8. COMPLAINTS: "Any competitor who wishes to lodge a complaint at an affiliated campdraft must lodge the complaint in writing with the Secretary of the host committee within one (1) hour of the incident taking place. A fee of \$100 must be lodged with the complaint. If the complaint is dismissed by the Committee, the \$100 is forfeited".

9. MEMBERSHIP: No ACA casual memberships are available.
